Advocacy / Reach 338, Sylvie d'Alcantara, **Administrator**

Let me introduce you to this year's Advocacy Committee members: Jacques Lambert, Micheline Jolicoeur, Guy Bouchard, Anita Miner and myself, Sylvie d'Alcantara.

To date, we have met with two federal MPs from our territory -Mr. Alexandre Boulerice (NDP) and Mr. Jean-Denis Garon (Bloc Québécois) - to discuss pharmacare, the national senior's strategy and improved retirement income security. A meeting with a third MP, Mr. Emmanuel Dubourg, to discuss priorities for veterans, is being set up.

The Branch also participated in a national consultation of the Canadian Medical Association on health policy. This

association focuses primarily on health policy, on vital issues such as access, equity, quality and system capacity. Our goals are to maintain ongoing collaboration, to share information and ensure follow-up. Advocacy remains a priority for federal retirees.
